Procedures

Stage I Post Information on Vacancies

Sponsorship

1. Financial support: pretax-RMB ¥ 12,500/month, for 6 or 12 months (N.B.: The Host Institute is responsible to deduct the personal income tax for the ATYSP according to Chinese regulation.)
2. Job opportunities: work with high-level research team in Guangxi and fulfill research tasks

3. Certification of ATYSP: proof of high-level research experience

Eligibility of Position

1. Non-confidential position
2. Non-degree education
3. Scientific research or policy study positions
4. Cross-culture and multi-national teams

Qualifications for Host Institutes

1. Legal entities in Guangxi: university, research institute or enterprise
2. Sound working conditions
3. Assisting the international expert in processing his/her necessary documents such as Entry Visa, Foreign Expert Certificate and Residence Permit for Foreigners
4. Providing financial support before sponsorship is allocated

Stage II Apply for the Position

Timeline

Year-round application

Reviewed every Jan., Apr., Jul. and Oct.

Eligibility of Applicants

1. Full-time job on scientific research or policy study in home country
2. With a doctoral degree or with over five years of research experience
3. Under or at the age of 45
4. Fluency in English or Chinese mandarin
5. Willing to work in GuangXi on a full- time basis
6. Comply with laws, regulations and other related rules in China.

Application Process



Stage III Work in China

1. Processing necessary documents such as Entry Visa, Foreign Expert Certificate and Residence Permit for Foreigners
2. Working with high-level research team in Guangxi and fulfill research tasks.

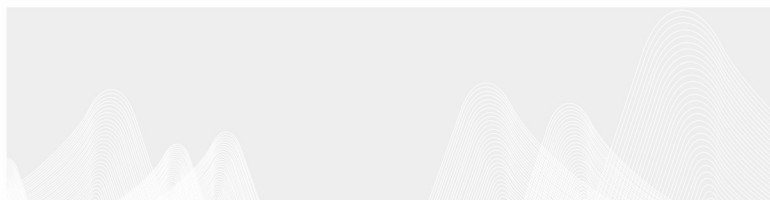
Beyond ATYSP

ATYSP Certification

When the program is finished, Guangxi Science and Technology Department will confer upon the participant the ATYSP Certificate based on his/her performance evaluation.

Project Tracking

The executive agency will continue to follow up on the project management, encourage foreign experts and their host institutes to keep cooperation, and apply for bilateral intergovernmental joint research projects.





China will enhance cooperation on innovation with other countries. Introduction

The ASEAN Talented Young Scientists (Guangxi) Program (hereinafter referred to as ATYSP) is an ASEAN oriented mobility scheme aimed at cultivating future leading scientists together with ASEAN Member States.

ATYSP promotes cross-border exchanges of excellent young scientists, scholars and researchers. ATYSP also enhances cooperation among research institutes, universities and enterprises.

ATYSP offers sponsorship (RMB 12,500/month, before tax) for talented young scientist who is going to work in Guangxi on full basis for 6 or 12 months together with Guangxi team.

ATYSP is sponsored by Finance Department of Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region. Special funds are allocated to support qualified young scientists, scholars and researchers of the ASEAN countries to carry out cooperative research on full time basis for 6 or 12 months in Guangxi. Talented young scientists from other countries may also be received in specific situation.

The competent authority of ATYSP is Guangxi Science and Technology Department which is in charge of the organization, implementation and management of the Program. In the implementation of ATYSP, Guangxi Science and Technology Department entrusts a third party organization to undertake the specific affairs of the Plan.

Cooperation Partners

Chinese partners

1. Competent Authority: Guangxi Science and Technology Department
2. Executive Agency: Guangxi University for Nationalities
3. Host Institute: A legal entity such as a research institute, a university or an enterprise that has been lawfully setup in Guangxi.

Foreign partners

1. Foreign Institute: The organization that the applicant serves in his home country.
2. Foreign Applicant: People who apply for ATYSP
